Decision to provide phone nos. /mobile nos. with the list of all evaluation Centre's and examination centre's to the Finance Officer, JUT, Ranchi for monitoring of advances taken by them from JUT. The agreement with M/s Habibulah & Co., Chartered Accountant has come to an end on 31.03.2022. During the Covid-19 epidemic period, the university conducted various examinations, under corona guidelines as issued by the government. Accordingly, social distancing among the examinees in the examination centers was maintained. Sanitizers and PPE-Kits were also arranged for, at the examination centers, for which extra expenses were incurred by the concerned centers. In light of this peculiar situation arising out from the compliance of corona guidelines, the then Examination Controller Shree Rajesh Prasad moved a proposal through file no- JUT/95/2018 at page 10/N to double the number of invigilators, as compared to normal time and to allow an expenses of Rs. 1,000/- (one thousand only) per-shift, per-day against purchase of sanitizers and PPE-Kites. The proposal moved by the EC has been approved by the then VC Dr. Gopal Pathak in the file on 12/12/2020. But, inadvertently the office order for the same could not be issued, nor the matter could be placed before the earlier meetings of the EC for approval. This notification no-JUT-303/2019/302, dated 03/03/2021 has been issued by the JUT for allowing the claim of examination centers on account of expenses incurred on making packets of answer booklets, its sealing and stationary item, prior to dispatching the answer booklets after the examination is over. These are the genuine expenses insured by every examination center while conducting the examination for which Rs.100/-(one hundred) per packet of 100 booklets, have been allowed w.e.f. 03/03/2021. However, the examination were conducted earlier also by the JUT, for which such claim is not admissible, in light of the above notification. On verbal order of the then VC Prof. P.K Mishra, a procurement of goods/services amounting to Rs. 6.07 lakh has been obtained from M/s. Arck Line Enterprises. As the goods/services have been obtained without following the proper process of purchase i.e. no work order being issued nor any recommendation made by purchase and sales committee, so the payment against such procurement is still pending. All such purchases and their Tax Invoices have been duly certified by the former Vice Chancellor and the then purchase officer of the JUT. The goods received have been entered into the stock register and are being utilized in the official residence of VC. For proper appreciation of facts and resolving the payment issue the following guidelines in this regard may be considered:- 1) As per the G.F.R.-2017 R-166 (ii) in a case of emergency the required goods are necessarily to be purchased from a particular source and the reason for such decision is to be recorded and approval of competent authority obtained, which has not been done in this case. For maintaining transparency in purchase, contract awarded on nomination basis the circular no. 4/4/21, dated 06.04.2021 issued by CVC says that all such types of contract awarded should be brought to the notice of chief executive body of the organization. 3) Bihar Financial Rule-13 says that delay in payment of money indisputably due by the government is contrary to all rules and budgetary principles and should be avoided. 4) Similarly Bihar Budget Manual Rule 107 says- The want of provision in the estimate does not operate to prevent payment of any sum really due by the government nor the want of sanction to prevent record of any actual payment. In the instant case the goods have been received and its qualities have been verified, entered into the stock register and also being put to use by the concerned official but its payment has been withheld due to noncompliance of proper procedure of purchase. 2) So, in light of the CVC circular as contained hereinabove, this matter is being placed before the Executive Council for approval so as to resolve the	After perusal and discussion at length by members present, it was approved with following suggestions: 1.
