In connection of the said directive, a Committee may be constituted for amendment of the MCA programme syllabus and draft the Rules and Regulations as per provision of the AICTE/UGC. This matter has to be placed before the Academic Council for perusal and needful directive. This matter has to be placed before the Academic Council for approval.	The members of the Academic Council unanimously approved the proposal.
16.	Proposal for Institutional Stipend for full time Ph.D. students admitted through written test followed by Interview.	In the Academic Session 2019-20, twenty two students had been selected to be enrolled in Ph.D. program on the basis of written test followed by Interview. Most of these students have valid GATE score or NET qualified. It is proposed to provide them Institutional Stipend of Rs 10,000/- per month for full time students. This matter has to be placed before the Academic Council for kind perusal and approval.	Proposal to provide Institutional Stipend of Rs 10,000/- per month for full time Ph.D. students is unanimously approved by the members of the Academic Council. The terms and conditions for the continuation of the Institutional Stipend shall be decided by a Committee headed by the Vice Chancellor.
17.	Demand of certain Institutes/ Colleges to start BBA/ BCA courses.	As per the Para 4 (ii) of the Jharkhand University of Technology Act 2011, "All existing colleges or institutions affiliated to State universities (except the institutions affiliated to deemed University) on the date of commencement of this Act, imparting Technical Education or Education coming under the purview of All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), New Delhi, shall be affiliated to this University." This matter has to be placed before the Academic Council for kind perusal.	The demand has been in principle approved by the Academic Council. The matter is referred to a Committee constituted by the Vice Chancellor.
18.	For the advancement of the University, an Advisory Committee has been constituted by the Vice Chancellor. It is proposed that the members of the Advisory Committee will be paid an Honorarium of Rs. 3000/- per day along with TA/DA.	The members of the proposed Advisory Committee is as follows: 1. Prof K. 20.	Any other matter with the permission of the Vice Chancellor cum Chairman, Academic Council.	By the permission of the Vice Chancellor cum Chairman, Academic Council, the Director, NIFFT, Hatia put up the matter of the Ph.D. students enrolled in NIFFT through written test followed by the interview in the Academic Session 2018-19. The registration of these students could not be taken up by the University due to the fact that the Ph.D. Programme in the University was started in the Academic Session 2019-20. The University came into the existence in the Academic Session 2018-19 and NIFFT, Hatia is affiliated to the University from the same Session i.e. 2018-19. Hence, the registration of these students are not taken up by Ranchi University to which NIFFT, Hatia was earlier affiliated i.e. before the Academic Session 2018-19. For the welfare of these students, he requested the Academic Council for the registration of these students to Jharkhand University of Technology, Ranchi.	The mythology of its implementation will be decided by a Committee constituted by Vice Chancellor. The members of the Academic Council unanimously approved the proposal.
