At the outset the Vice-Chancellor extended warm welcome to all the members present in the meeting of 11th Academic Council. Thereafter, the agenda items were taken up for discussion and needful directive:-

1.	Adaptation of the “Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar” as issued by the UGC, Letter no. D.O. No. F.1-1/2021 (Secy), dated 16th July 2021, in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic. (Annexure- 1)	In view of the COVID-19 Pandemic and subsequent lockdowns, the University Grants Commission (UGC) has issued "Guidelines on Examinations and Academic Calendar- July 2021 for the Universities (Annexure- 1). This matter is being placed before the Academic Council for perusal and needful directives.	After perusal and discussion at length by the members present, it was approved and directed to adopt the said guidelines for University's Academic & Examination Calendar (for academic session 2021).
2.	Post facto approval for the extension of the last date for the grant of affiliation by the JUT, till 10th of August, 2021. (Annexure-2)	AICTE has issued a revised calendar of activities for AY 2021-22 in the wake of COVID-19 pandemic. In this revised calendar the last date for issuing of Grant of Affiliation by Universities has been extended till 10th August, 2021. This matter is being placed before the Academic Council for perusal and post facto approval of the same.	After perusal & discussion, unanimously approved by the members present.

3.	Fixation of fixed monthly honorarium for the services of the newly nominated Advisors for Advisory Committee of the JUT, vide notification no. JUT-513/2021/351, JUT-513/2021/212, JUT-617/2021/599, JUT-617/2021/598, Dated 12/03/2021, 17/02/2021, 14/05/2021, 14/05/2021; respectively. This has reference to the University's notification no. 47, dated 12/01/2021 (Annexure-3)	For the smooth functioning and advancement of the University, vide notification no. 47, dated 12/01/2021 Advisory Committee has been constituted. Under the agenda number 18 of the 8th Academic Council, held on 12/01/2021, it was also approved that said constituted committee is dynamic in nature and more suitable members will be added in due course of time, the members of the Advisory Committee will be paid an honorarium of Rs. 3000/- per day along with TA/DA. As we are well aware about paucity of skilled and experienced manpower in the University, therefore, services of some advisors may be taken for monthly basis till further order, in this regards monthly paid honorarium may also be fixed of Rs. 36000/- (thirty six thousand) maximum only. This matter is being placed before the Academic Council for perusal and needful directive.	After perusal and discussion at length by the members present, it was directed that the term, "fixed monthly Honorarium" should not be used, however, the maximum Honorarium to be paid in a month should not exceed from Rs. 36000/- (Thirty Six Thousand Only).

Guidance sought on the suggestion received from the Director, Guru Gobind Singh Educational Society's Technical Campus (GGSESTC), Kandra, Chas, Bokaro has for improving the enrolments in	The Director, GGSESTC, Kandra, Chas Bokaro, an affiliated college of the JUT, in his letter no. GGSESTC/ Kandra/ JUT/ 119/ 2021, dated 13/7/2021 has raised his concern that due to Covid 19 Pandemic the enrolment/ registration in first year B.Tech has reduced drastically. Further, he has suggested that to overcome this challenge following measures should be undertaken by the JUT: 1. Formation of advisory committee consisting of representatives of self-finance colleges; 2. Implementation of New Eligibility Criteria for B.Tech first year admission; approved by AICTE APH-	After perusal and detailed discussion, it was resolved by the members present that effort shall be made to improve upon the enrollment through open counseling at different centers designated by the JUT among the affiliated Colleges.

5.	Principal, R.V.S. College of Engineering and Technology, Jamshedpur, in his letter no. RVSCET/ P/ LC/ 088/ 21, dated 2nd July 2021, has requested to recognise R.V.S. College of Engineering and Technology, Jamshedpur as a Research Centre for Ph.D. in C.S.E. program. (Annexure-5).	In the light of said letter, Principal, R.V.S., Jamshedpur has stated that R.V.S. College of Engineering and Technology was established in year 2004. Presently imparting education in five (5) U.G. branches of engineering comprising of Civil, Mechanical, Electrical, Computer Science and Electronics and Communication and two (02) P.G. courses comprising of M.Tech. (Computer Science) and M.C.A. In the said letter he has requested to include the Institute as a Research Centre for Computer Science for Ph.D. program. This matter is being placed before the Academic Council for discussion and needful directive.	After perusal and detailed discussion, it was resolved by the members present that under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor a committee shall be constituted to finalize the standard proforma and to scrutinize the proposal to establish Research & Development Centers in affiliated Colleges. The final decision in this regards shall be taken by the said Committee.
6.	Post facto approval sought for the decision made vide letter no. JUT/518/2021/ 264Ex, dated 17/03/2021, related to phase wise opening of the Colleges, publication of results, conduct of examinations and other matters for B.Tech. (Annexure-6).	As per decision taken in a meeting held under the Chairmanship of the Vice-Chancellor, JUT on 15th March, 2021 decisions related to phase wise opening of colleges, publication of results, conduct of examinations and other matters for B.Tech. program were taken. This is being placed before the Academic Council for perusal and post facto approval.	After perusal and discussion, unanimously approved by the members present.

7.	Post facto approval of the decisions related to the examination, in view of the COVID-19 Pandemic. As per the guidelines issued on examinations by U.G.C./ A.I.C.T.E, the University has notified vide letter no. JUT/ 43/ 2018/ 218Ex, dated 15/09/2020. (Annexure-7).	In the view of COVID-19 Pandemic and as per the issued guidelines on Examinations by U.G.C./ A.I.C.T.E, and in the welfare of the students, University has notified vide letter no. JUT/ 43/ 2018/ 218Ex, dated 15/09/2020 and decided that Examinations fee for cancelled examinations shall be adjusted in next examinations fee and Examination fee for Intermediate Semester to promote the students has also been reduced with amount of Rs. 500/- (Five hundred).
